2022 Festival of India Video Contest

India Association of Charlotte invites entries from **high school** for a video contest. Entries should address this year's theme – "**Kashmiriyat**".

Students should assume they are a reporter for a major tv network (or YouTube channel). As a reporter, they will research and create a video on what is **Kashmiriyat**.

FOI 2022 Video Contest Rules

1. Contest will be submitted by Grade level 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th high school students.
2. Students can enter as a group of up to four members from the same grade level only. One of the students from the group will lead the team as the **group leader**.
3. Prizes for each **student** are: First place - \$100; Second place - \$75; Third place - \$50.
4. Project can be Student led or teacher led (Prize money will be distributed accordingly).
5. Only one entry is allowed per student and the deadline for submission is July 31, 2022.
6. Submission guidelines:
 - Video must be from **four - five minutes** in length. Please see rubric on next page.
 - Video resolution needs to be HD resolution or higher and **must be an original work** of the contestants.
7. Submission process
 - Create a video and upload your video on YouTube.
 - The title of the video should follow this format: "**Name_Video title**"
 - Set the video's private setting to "unlisted."
 - When you upload a video on YouTube, by default it is set as a public video, so change it into unlisted. "Unlisted" means that only people who know the link to the video can view it. Any video that is released to the public or set as private will not be considered for the competition.
 - Follow these steps to successfully upload your video onto YouTube:
 - Sign into your YouTube account; Click the Upload button;
 - Select the video which you would like to upload;
 - Add a title (Name_Video title) and description;
 - Select unlisted from the YouTube privacy drop down; and Click Publish.
8. The video will be produced and developed under the guidance of parent.

9. Winners will be notified by email by Aug 1st, 2022. The top three entries will be awarded a prize. **Award-winning videos will be published to a FOI Website and social media** to be enjoyed by a broader audience.

10. Each student needs to fill both **Registration** and **Parent Consent** forms.

11. Family Members of the FOI 2022 Committee members are **NOT ALLOWED** to participate in the contest.
