### **2022 Festival of India Video Contest**

India Association of Charlotte invites entries from **high school** for a video contest. Entries should address this year's theme – "**Kashmiriyat**".

Students should assume they are a reporter for a major tv network (or YouTube channel). As a reporter, they will research and create an original video on what is **Kashmiriyat**.

**Kashmiriyat** (also spelled as **Kashmiriat**) is the centuries-old indigenous tradition of communal harmony and religious syncretism in the Kashmir Valley.

#### **FOI 2022 Video Contest Rules**

1. Contest entry should be created by Grade level 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> high school students with parent or teacher permission
2. Students can enter as a group of up to four members from the same grade level only. One of the students from the group will lead the team as the **group leader**.
3. Prizes for **Each winning student** are: First place - \$100; Second place - \$75; Third place - \$50. **FOI committee decides how the prizes are distributed**. Teacher led team's prize will go to the sponsoring teacher.
4. Project can be Student led or Teacher led (Prize money will be distributed accordingly Per FOI discretion). The video will be produced and developed under the **guidance of parent or teacher**.

5. Only one entry is allowed per group and the deadline for submission is July 31, 2022.
6. Submission guidelines:
  - Video must be from **four - five minutes** in length. **Please see rubric on next page**.
  - Video resolution needs to be HD resolution or higher
  - Video **must be an original work** of the contestants.
7. Submission process
  - Create a video and upload your video on YouTube.
    - The title of the video should follow this format: "**Name\_Video title**"
  - Set the video's private setting to "unlisted."
    - When you upload a video on YouTube, by default it is set as a public video, so change it into unlisted. "Unlisted" means that only people who know the link to the video can view it. Any video that is released to the public or set as private will not be considered for the competition.
  - Follow these steps to successfully upload your video onto YouTube:
    - Sign into your YouTube account; Click the Upload button;
    - Select the video which you would like to upload;

- Add a title (Name\_Video title) and description;
- Select unlisted from the YouTube privacy drop down; and Click Publish.
- Each student in the team needs to fill both Registration and Parent Consent Forms.
- Email the YouTube link, the completed Registration and Parent Consent Forms to [kaul.amit@gmail.com](mailto:kaul.amit@gmail.com) by July 31, 2022.

8. Winners will be notified by email by Aug 8th, 2022. The top three entries will be awarded a prize. **Award-winning videos will be published to a FOI Website and social media** to be enjoyed by a broader audience. Winning teams will be invited on the stage at Belk Theater on August 27, 2022.

9. Family Members of the **FOI 2022 School Exhibit Committee members** are **NOT ALLOWED** to participate in the contest.
